

# LOOKING FOR AN ABORIGINAL EXPERIENCE?

## Speaking in Colour can supply your needs

### Workshops available:

- “Interwoven” (Aboriginal Weaving)
- “Possum” (Possum Skin Cloaks)
- “Appreciation” (Aboriginal Art Appreciation)
- “Time to Move” (Aboriginal Dance)
- Didji and Artifact Displays
- Storytelling by Local Elders

### “Time to Move” (Aboriginal Dance) - 1 presenter

3.5 hours per session min 30mins with each class sized group.

Cost: \$500 + GST

Activity: Students get to learn a few dance moves, dance to a pre-recorded song and have their face painted in ochre.



### “Interwoven” (Aboriginal Weaving) - 1 presenter

3.5 hours per session min 30mins with each class sized group.

Cost: \$580 + GST

Materials: for 160 students, \$0.50c for students there after.

Activity: Students learn about Traditional Aboriginal weaving, how when and why. Students then learn a contemporary weaving technique creating a little keep sake.

### “Appreciation” (Aboriginal Art Appreciation) - 1 presenter

3.5 hours per session min 30mins with each class sized group.

Cost: \$500 + GST

Materials: school can supply at own cost paper, painter pens etc or

Poska activity @ \$0.50c pp

Wooden Boomerangs \$15pp

Picture frames \$15 pp

Cards \$10 pp

Canvas \$8-15pp

Activity: Students learn about how to be inspired by Traditional Aboriginal art to create something contemporary in a culturally appropriate way. Each student creates a little keepsake from the day.



### “Possum” (Possum Skin Cloaks) - 1 presenter

3.5 hours per session min 30mins with each class sized group.

Cost: \$500 + GST

Materials: arm band @ \$5-10 pp depending on size.

Activity: Students learn about Possum Skin Cloaks, their role in society, how they were made and why. Students get to touch a Possum skin Cloak, play with masks and do a little possum dance. There is an option to create an artwork, burning onto a piece of possum leather making an armband, at a cost.
